Please Park vehicles only in authorized areas. Parking is not allowed alongside of the pavilion or on grassy areas. Use the back gate for handicap access or to unload supplies. A vehicle may unload using this access but then must be returned to the parking lot. Vehicles parked on the grass or left in the pavilion area will result in forfeiture of your security deposit. Glass bottles are not allowed in the Town Park. Sorry, no pets.

SEVASTOPOL TOWN PARK PAVILION

**4830 Ripp Road, located at the intersection of Hwy 57 & Ripp
Road**

Approximately 5 miles north of Sturgeon Bay

Users have access to the pavilion, outside lights, and electric outlets. They can also reset any of the outside outlet circuit breakers if needed. There is a gray electrical box (labeled) located next to the small access door in the pavilion that will turn on the exterior lights and/or allow the users to reset the circuit breakers if needed for the external outlets. This box is not locked and is safe for user access. Please remember to turn off the lights, if used.

Pavilion users may use the round trash barrels adjacent to the pavilion for convenient disposal. Restrooms are located at the concession stand. Please use the back gate entrance for unloading/loading/handicap access. Parking is not allowed alongside of the pavilion. A vehicle may unload but the must be returned to the parking lot.
